IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

- Non-diploma exams Social 10/20 and ELA 10/20 will run on January 16 and 17. To accommodate
 writing space and time we are opting for Mega Blocks. On January 16th we would run P1 (AM), P3(PM)
 and on January 17th we would run P2 (AM), P4(PM).
- Students are expected to write their exams on the expected date and time. Any
 unique/extraordinary circumstances need to be appealed to the exam coordinator, Assistant
 Principal, Krishani Starnes as soon as possible.
- In the unlikely situation where a student has two exams in the same block, accommodations may be made on a case-by-case basis in discussion with Assistant Principal, Krishani Starnes
- Science 10/20, Chem 20, Bio 20, Math 10/20 and Physics 20 exams will be written from Monday,
 January 22nd to Wednesday, January 24th.
- Teachers and departments will communicate their tutorial schedules with all students
- Opportunities during tutorials include: Course Completion Opportunities such as targeted assistance
 with assignment completion for specific outcomes, targeted support or intervention, targeted
 reassessment opportunities, as well as credit recovery, and
- For all Diploma Exams all students are provided with up to double the official time, as posted, if they require it
- Students should arrive at least 15 minutes before the exam
- Students must show a valid ID to enter the exam space
- Students should come prepared with the necessary test writing materials (pencil, eraser, highlighter, pen, whiteout, approved calculator, water bottle, snack, etc.)
- Please, no coats, hats, backpacks, cellphones, or electronic devices (other than approved calculators)
 may be brought into the exam room
- Textbooks should be returned before each exam
